

Central Core

A PRESENTATION SURROUNDED BY ROCKETS & SATELLITES!

Central Core is the biggest 'room' that Space Expo has to offer. In this area, you are literally surrounded by rockets and satellites and you can overlook the entire exhibition. INFORMAL DRINKS ON THE MOON!

Space Station Square is situated next to a large-scale model of the International Space Station (ISS) and borders the spectacular lunar landscape that serves as backdrop for the lunar module and Neil Armstrong. The perfect place for a networking event over informal drinks or a presentation. The stairway to the International Space Station also offers a perfect stage for speeches or presentations.



By one of our enthusiastic guides



Technical support & audio-visual resources

CAREFREE, WITH ONE SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT

The Ariane Room and Astronaut Room are equipped with a range of screens and audio-visual resources. At the moment, there are no audio-visual resources permanently installed in the Central Core or Space Station Square. However, we regularly call on the expertise of our preferred supplier, ML Systems, to add temporary equipment to those rooms. This is a supplier we trust, since they are familiar with the possibilities of our location. If you notify us about your preferences, we will work with ML Systems to arrange all the technical equipment you need. You will have only one point of contact. If you would like to arrange the technical set-up yourself, that is possible in collaboration with our technical support staff.

Parking & accessibility

PARKING

Parking is never an issue at Space Expo; we have our own (free) parking lot that accommodates more than 120 cars, right in front of our building.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

There is a bus stop directly across from the Space Expo building. It is easy to travel to Space Expo using public transport, either from Leiden Central Station (20 minutes) or The Hague Central Station (40 minutes).

BY PASSENGER VEHICLE

From the A44 motorway from Amsterdam or The Hague, you take the exit Leiden Transferium/ Katwijk/Rijnsburg/Valkenburg. Follow road signs to Rijnsburg/Katwijk, and then straight on to the N206. From provincial road N206 (from Leiden), take exit Katwijk/industrieterrein 't Heen.
